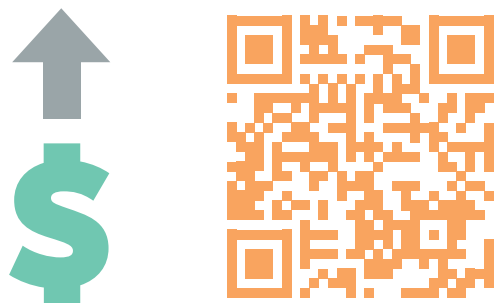
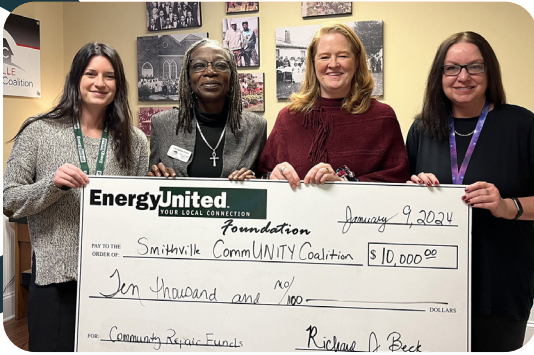

## HOW WE HELP

The EnergyUnited Foundation is made up of volunteer board members that review all applications. Together they allocate funds to families in need.

The Foundation plays a critical role in providing support for those who are facing financial hardship each year. Since its beginning in 1996, the EnergyUnited Foundation has granted over \$9 million to nearly 5,100 individuals, households and nonprofit organizations in need of financial assistance.

## ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

For over 25 years, members of EnergyUnited have been rounding up their bills to help their neighbors in need. This program has been vital in assisting members, their neighbors and area nonprofits in meeting needs that arise in times of crisis.

Foundation funds are generously donated by EnergyUnited members who allow their monthly electric bills to be rounded up to the next highest even dollar. The rounded-up amount will range from 1 cent to 99 cents and will average about 50 cents a month, or \$6.00 a year.

Guidelines for awarding the money are based on urgent needs for housing, utilities, and humane needs. Funds are also donated to nonprofit organizations helping people meet these same needs.

## THE IMPACT OF ROUNDING UP

The Foundation is funded by members who participate in our Operation Round-Up. We are proud to share that nearly 80,000 EnergyUnited members currently round up their bills each month. **IN 2023**, the Foundation funded over \$900,000 in grants throughout our community. We helped our applicants with bill payments, home repairs and medical equipment assistance, and supported a variety of local nonprofits. In addition, the Foundation granted nearly \$25,000 to members who applied for the Heating Assistance program and over \$18,000 to those who applied for the Energy Assistance program.

**WE PARTNERED** with Habitat for Humanity of North Carolina, awarding an historic \$100,000 grant in 2023. The funds were divided between their 16 affiliates throughout our service area. We're proud to continue working with such an amazing organization to help create lasting, meaningful change in our communities.
