



The Future of Electricity: Safety

Leadership Development: Building a safety-first culture through workforce training. **Tree Management Program:** Addressed yard trees as major outage causes, improving safety and reliability by 20%.

Community Engagement: Sharing information with our communities through electrical safety demonstrations at local schools and featured stories in our communications channels.



The Future of Electricity: Reliability

AMI Upgrades: Real-time monitoring and faster outage response.

Infrastructure Investments: Doubled spending in five years to meet growing demand.

Multi-Year Investment: EU is investing \$216 million to enhance reliability and energy supply.

AI and Data Insights: AI optimizes grid performance and can help us identify hazardous trees on our system. AI is also increasing the demand for electricity.






The Future of Electricity: Affordability

- Legislative Engagement: Incorporating more renewables on the grid and working with legislators to advocate for smart energy policies.





Meter and Voltage Status Checks Team Coordination (multiple shifts)






24-Hour Coverage

Shift-Based Operations: Staff transitions occur at 06:00, 14:00, and 18:00, ensuring continuous operations. Regional Communication: Monitor and dispatch across multiple regions, including Foothills, Lake Norman and Triad areas.

Incident Monitoring: Stay alert to alarms and dispatch emergency responses based on system and truck alerts.


