Provide EnergyUnited with an account and routing number for your checking or savings. Drafts will occur automatically within 10 days of the billing date shown on your statement. EnergyUnited is owned and jointly run by over 107,000 members, which means each and every one of you has a direct say-so in how we run the business. Your opinions matter, your voice deserves to be heard and the future of our co-op greatly depends on your active participation in our meetings, events, elections and more.

With roots leading back to the 1930s, EnergyUnited still continues to operate as a strong, communityminded electric cooperative. Each of our members is part of what makes this cooperative exceptional. This October, EnergyUnited will celebrate 80 years as a co-op family. Look for more details about this special anniversary in the October edition of Connect.

Each year, nominees are chosen from within the co-op's membership to run for board positions. The individuals elected comprise the EnergyUnited Board of Directors and thereby make the final call on all major co-op decisions, from setting policies to determining the rates we charge for electricity. For that reason, it's important to elect a truly representative board.

The upcoming election will begin on August 10, 2018. As a valued member-owner, we strongly encourage you to check out our official 2018 Board of Directors Voting Guide so you can get to know the nominees. The guide will be sent with your ballot and can be found on our website. Once you're informed, cast your vote by September 10, 2018. There are two ways to let your voice be heard: a hard copy ballot via U.S. Mail or, much easier, an electronic ballot via email. If we don't have your email address, keep an eye out for a hard copy ballot which will be mailed on August 10, 2018. If we do have your email address, expect to receive an electronic ballot on August 10, 2018. As an added incentive to cast your vote, three voters will be randomly selected to receive a \$100 Visa gift card or a \$100 bill credit. If's a win-win.

Electric cooperatives are born when communities join together in support of their neighbors and bring electricity to hard-to-reach rural areas. With that in mind, we hope that you join together once again for our 2018 Board of Directors Election. It is important that each of our members has a voice and participates in this year's voting process. Election results will be announced at our Annual Meeting at our Statesville headquarters (IT Building) on Thursday, September 20, 2018, at 4:00 p.m. We can't wait to see you there!
