STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Eligibility: Open to high school students in our 19 county service area who are planning to attend a college, university or technical school during the 2019-20 school year.

To be eligible, students must:

- Students must reside in a home/apartment/condo/townhouse that is serviced by EnergyUnited OR attend a school that is serviced by EnergyUnited.
 - We serve the following high schools in our 19 county service area: Central Davidson, Davie County Early College, Davie County, Hopewell, Ledford, North Iredell, South Davidson, West Iredell and William Amos Hough. These students automatically become eligible to apply, regardless of their home address.
- Complete application and submit with student resume. Student resume should include any awards or honors received, any school organizations, athletics, community organizations you are involved with and any volunteering you do. If you have work experience, please list.
- Provide two letters of recommendation from your school staff (ex: teacher, coach, principal, or another staff member of your choice).
- As part of the application, you are required to answer **two questions**—see below. Each essay/response should be no longer than 500 words. Please include your first and last name along with your school name on the top right hand corner of the essay.
